

# Mid-Con Players of the Week



Lyndsay Bigler, Centenary Sr., F, Baytown, Texas

Newcomer Centenary posts its first Player of the Week honors, as Lyndsay Bigler earns the title for her efforts last week. Bigler helped the Ladies to a 1-1 split, as they defeated Mississippi Valley State (5-

1) before falling to TCU (2-0). The senior recorded her first hat trick of the season in the win over Mississippi Valley State, scoring two goals within a 2:25 span in the first half, including the game-winner. Her third goal came 5:34 later for a total of three goals in 7:59. Bigler now leads the Ladies on the season in points (6) and goals (3) and is tied with Oral Roberts' Jessica Kellogg for the most points in the conference.

### DFFFNSIVF Sarah Buckland, Oakland Sr., GK., Burlington, Ontario

Sarah Buckland was once again a solid presence in net for the Golden Grizzlies in the second week of play, as Oakland posted a 1-1 record at the Nike Challenge in Ann Arbor, Mich. The senior recorded seven

saves to protect a 1-0 victory against host Michigan, helping to earn Oakland's first win against the Wolverines in school history. Buckland then went on to total five saves in a 2-0 loss to Marquette. The senior did not allow a goal in her first 309:49 of work in 2003, and has extended her school and Mid-Con career shutouts record to 21. This is the second week in a row that she has been named the Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week.

## Team-by-Team Schedule and Results



### AROUND THE MID-CON...

MID-CON TEAMS OFF TO TOUGH START : The six teams that comprise the Mid-Con have posted a combined 6-17-1 (.271) record to start the season, with only two teams recording wins last week. Oakland went 1-1, defeating Michigan (1-0) before falling to Marquette (1-0) at the Nike Challenge. Centenary also posted a 1-1 record, defeating Mississippi Valley State (5-1) before dropping a contest to TCU (2-0). Oral Roberts suffered its first loss of the season, dropping a 3-1 decision to Arkansas; that snapped a 16-match unbeaten streak for the Golden Eagles dating back to last season. IUPUI (0-2), Southern Utah (0-3), Valparaiso (0-4) and Western Illinois (0-3) are still in search of a win.

ORAL ROBERTS STREAK STOPPED: Oral Roberts suffered its first loss of the season last week, falling to Arkansas by a 3-1 score. The defeat was the first for the Golden Grizzlies in 16 matches, dating back to last season. It was also the first road match of the season, as Oral Roberts' first two wins against Stephen F. Austin (5-0) and Texas Tech (3-0) were at ORU Soccer Complex.

OAKLAND PROVES TOUGH TO TOP OPPONENTS: Oakland, picked first in the Mid-Con preseason poll, went 1-1 last week, defeating Michigan 1-0, while falling to Marquette 1-0 at the Nike Challenge in Ann Arbor, Mich. The Golden Grizzlies' win against Michigan marked the second straight win over a Big Ten opponent (Oakland also defeated Illinois, 1-0, on August 29th) and made a little history, as the Wolverines were the one opponent that Oakland had not defeated from the state of Michigan. Goalkeeper Sarah Buckland, the Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week recipient for the second straight week, proved to be a solid presence in goal for the Golden Grizzlies, totaling seven saves against 21 shots in the win. The senior also extended her career shutouts record to 21 in the victory. Oakland's schedule will again prove to be a challenge as the Golden Grizzlies take on No. 4 UCLA next week.

OAKLAND EARNS REGION RANKINGS FROM NSCAA: Oakland's performance in the first two weeks of the regular season was enough to earn them Great Lakes Region rankings from the NSCAA. The Golden Grizzlies are eighth this week, dropping from fifth place last week.
