# Oral Roberts and Valparaiso advance to Mid-Con Women's Soccer Championship game

ROCHESTER, MICH.-The two semfinal matches in the 2004 Mid-Con Women's Soccer Championship produced a single a goal between them, as #1 seed Oral Roberts (14-5-0, 5-1-0) and #3 seed Valparaiso (11-7-2, 3-3-0) advanced to the Championship game. Oral Roberts' edged Oakland in penalty kicks, while Valpo topped Centenary 1-0 in regulation.

Oral Roberts and Valparaiso meet on Sunday, November 7 for the Mid-Con Championship and automatic berth to the NCAA Women's Soccer College Cup. Oral Roberts won the two teams only meeting between the teams this season, topping Valpo 1-0 eight days ago.

Top seeded Oral Roberts and #4 seed Oakland (8-12-0, 3-3-0) started off the 2004 Mid-Con Championship with 110 minutes of scoreless action, as the two teams were forced to resort to penalty kicks to settle their semifinal match. The Golden Eagles ousted the host Golden Grizzlies from the tournament with a 3-2 triumph. Oral Roberts' Tayah Gillespie kicked home the third and decisive penalty shot for Oral Roberts to seal the Golden Eagles spot in the Championship game. The teams were even in nearly every statistical category after two regulation halves and a pair of overtime periods. Oral Roberts' Jessica Kellogg and Oakland's Kristi Swaving, both of whom were First Team All Mid-Con selections and led their respective teams in scoring, managed five shots apiece, including two on goal. Golden Eagles goalkeeper Stef Gurley recorded three saves, one more than her Golden Grizzlies counterpart, Jessica Howard. Both teams finished with 13 fouls, while OU topped ORU by a single shot (13-12).

In the second match of the day, #3 seed Valparaiso pulled the upset of #2 seed Centenary (14-6-1, 4-2-0), as the Crusaders pulled out a 1-0 decision. Valpo's Allison Swanson took a pass from Kristi Dixon in 27th minute and beat Centenary goalkeeper Lindsey Stafford. The eventual game-winner was Swanson's sixth goal of the season. Valpo goalie Erin Murray made one save on her way to the shutout victory, while Stafford also stopped one shot. The Crusaders outshot the Ladies, 7-3, although each team only recorded one shot on goal.

### Oral Roberts wins Mid-Con Championship with 3-1 triumph over Valparaiso

ROCHESTER, MICH. - The 2004 Mid-Con Women's Soccer Championship game between #1 seed Oral Roberts (14-5-1, 5-1-0) and #3 seed Valparaiso (10-7-0, 3-3-0) was a rematch of the inaugural 1999 tourney. It took Oral Roberts overtime to knock off the Crusaders five years ago, but Sunday's task proved to be a bit easier for the Golden Eagles as ORU defeated Valparaiso, 3-1. The Golden Eagles, who earn the Mid-Con's automatic berth into the 2004 NCAA Women's College Cup, claim their first Mid-Con tourney title since 1999 and second Mid-Con crown overall.

Oral Roberts scored three times in the first 17 minutes of the Championship match and neither offense found the back net from that point on, as the Eagles prevailed 3-1. Jessica Kellogg got the ORU offense on track early when she fed the ball to Emily Gagnon, who scored 5:01 into the contest. Gentry Detter, who was the Mid-Con Championship MVP, notched the game-winner for the Golden Eagles less than eight minutes later as she scored off of a Heather Hall assist. Valpo fired back as Lindsay Holley made it a one-goal game when she beat ORU goalkeeper Stef Gurley in the 14th minute. The game remained 2-1 until the 16:18 mark, when Kellogg, the 2004 Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Year, notched her 18th goal of the year. Oral Roberts outshot Valpo, 13-9, for the match.

### Oral Roberts to face off against Nebraska in opening round of NCAA College Cup

ELMHURST, ILL.-Oral Roberts, the winners of the 2004 Mid-Con Women's Soccer Championship, received the conference's automatic postseason berth and will face off against Nebraska in the first round of the 2004 NCAA Women's College Cup. The Golden Eagles and Cornhuskers will face off in Lawrence, Kansas on the campus of the University of Kansas, who earned a #8 seed.

Oral Roberts was the Mid-Con's top-team during the regular season, as the Golden Eagles finished 14-5-1 overall and 5-1-0 in conference play. ORU entered the Mid-Con Championship as the top-seed and opened the tourney by defeating #4 seed Oakland in penalty kicks, 3-2, after regulation ended in a 0-0 tie. Oral Roberts' scored three goals in the opening 17 minutes of the Championship match, as the Golden Eagles defeated #3 seed Valparaiso 3-1. Oral Roberts' won the Mid-Con's inaugural tournament title in 1999, but did not advance to the NCAA Women's College Cup. The Mid-Con tournament winner now receives an automatic berth into the 64-team single-elimination postseason tournament.

The Golden Eagles have been consistent on both side of the ball this season, as they boast the Mid-Con Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year. Junior forward Jessica Kellogg took offensive honors after leading the Mid-Con in goals (17) and points (36) and ranking in the Top 20 nationally in both categories as well. Sophomore defender Gentry Detter earned the defensive award, as she anchored the top defense in the Mid-Con. Detter was also named MVP of the Mid-Con Championship, after scoring the game-winning goal against Valparaiso. Sophomore forward Heather Hall (7 goals- 8 assists - 22 points) and freshman midfielder Emily Gagnon (5-7-17) were both First Team All Mid-Con selections after combining for 12 goals, 15 assists and 39 points. Freshman goalkeeper Stef Gurley was also a First Team All Mid-Con member, as she led the league with eight shutouts and 0.88 goals against average.

Nebraska earned an at-large bid out of the Big XII Conference after finishing the season 12-7-0 overall and 6-4-0 in conference play. The Huskers bowed out of the Big XII Tournament in the first round after falling to Texas, 2-0, and enter the postseason amidst a three-game losing streak.

The Golden Eagles Ione victory over a Big XII squad this season, was a 1-0 overtime triumph against Oklahoma, who knocked off the Huskers by the same tally in late October. Nebraska will be the fourth Big XII opponent the Golden Eagles will face this season. ORU fell to a pair of Big XII teams in Texas Tech (6-2) and Oklahoma State (2-1) that Nebraska has defeated this season.
