## AROUND THE MID-CON...



VALPARAISO WIDENS CONFERENCE LEAD: After taking sole possession of first place two weeks ago, Valparaiso strengthed its hold on the top spot with a win over Centenary (2-0) which gives the Crusaders nine points (3-0-0). Southern Utah is in second with five points (1-0-2) thanks to a 2-1 upset win over Oral Roberts Saturday, Western Illinois checks in third place with four points (1-1-1), while Oral Roberts and Centenary are tied for fourth with three points each (1-2-0).

**OF NOTE:** Centenary's **Ali Hilsher**'s 7.56 saves per game ranks 16th in the NCAA and her 93 saves puts her just 25 behind the single-season school record with five matches to play ... Three players are tied atop the goals board as Oakland's **Kristi Swaving**, Oral Roberts' **Jessica Kellogg** and Valparaiso's **Kendall Brown** each have eight tallies ... Kellogg leads the league in points and assists with 21 and five, respectively.

#### TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: The Ladies split a pair of road conference matches last weekend against Valparaiso (0-2) and IUPUI (1-0). The win over IUPUI snapped a four-match losing streak ... Ali Hilsher recorded back-to-back double digit saves with 15 against Valparaiso and 10 against IUPUI. She ranks 16th in the NCAA in saves per game and is 25 saves shy of the single-season school record with five matches to go.

**IUPUI:** IUPUI went 0-2-0 last week, dropping matches to IPFW (3-0) and conference foe Centenary (1-0) ... Amazingly enough, IUPUI's record against its two opponents entering last week was a combined 0-7-0 ... **Jessie Mann** continues her brilliant season in goal as her 1.62 GAA is on pace for the second-best season in school history. She already owns the top spot with a 1.45 GAA which she set a year ago

OAKLAND: Oakland opened up conference play with a 3-2 loss on the road to Western Illinois. The loss is the first in school history to the Westerwinds ... Kristi Swaving continued her strong offensive season by tallying both goals in the loss. She is now tied for the league lead in goals with eight ... The Golden Grizzlies will play two league matches this week as they host both Southern Utah and IUPUI.

**ORAL ROBERTS:** The Golden Eagles fell to 1-2-0 in league play with a 2-1 loss to Southern Utah last week ... **Jessica Kellogg** had a goal and an assist in the win over Northeastern (Okla.). She is tied for the league lead in goals and leads in points ... The preseason favorite has had a rough start to their conference season, they are tied for fourth after three weeks of conference play ... Oral Roberts will look to reverse that trend this week as it hosts Western Illinois after a non-conference home tilt with Nebraska.

**SOUTHERN UTAH:** The Thunderbirds went 1-0-1 last week against Oral Roberts (2-1) and North Dakota State (1-1) ... The win over ORU vaulted Southern Utah into sole possession of second place in the league standings ... **Catherine Johnson** tallied a goal in both games for her first two goals of the season ... After three consecutive home matches, the Thunderbirds will hit the road this week for a conference match with Oakland Thursday and a non-conference matchup with Cleveland State Friday.

VALPARAISO: Valparaiso continued its hold on the top spot in the league standings with a 2-0 win over Centenary ... Lori Johnson continued her recent offensive surge with a goal against the Ladies ... The Crusaders are 3-0-0 in conference play for only the third time in school history ... Valpo will hit the road on Friday for a conference match against IUPUI before returning home on Sunday for a non-conference matchup against Youngstown State.

**WESTERN ILLINOIS:** Western Illinois posted its first-ever win over Oakland with a 3-2 decision last week. After going up 3-0, the Westerwinds needs a late save from **Loes Guerts** to preserve the win ... Western Illinois will look to continue the momentum for its two road conference matches this week against Centenary and Oral Roberts.
