AROUND THE MID-CON...



VALPARAISO MAINTAINS CONFERENCE LEAD PAST MIDWAY POINT: Valparaiso remains the lone conference unbeaten after last week's action. The Crusaders are 4-0-0 (12 points) in Mid-Con play, Western Illinois checks in at second with a 2-2-1 mark (7 points) while Oakland (2-1-0) and Oral Roberts (2-2-0) are tied for third with six points apiece.

OF NOTE: Centenary's **Ali Hilsher** tied her own school record for single-game saves with 17 in a loss to Western Illinois and just one match later tied the school record for single-season saves with 118. Hilsher also is ranked in two categories on the NCAA leaderboard, she's ninth in saves per game (8.45) and 12th in shots on goal save percentage (.886).

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary went 0-2-0 last week against Western Illinois (5-1) and Stephen F. Austin (1-0) ... Ali Hilsher continued her strong play in goal with her second 17 save effort this season. She tied the Ladies single-season saves record and is ranked ninth in the NCAA in saves per game (8.45) and 12th in shots on goal save percentage (.886).

IUPUI: IUPUI went 0-2-0 last week, dropping conference matches to Valparaiso (2-0) and Oakland (3-0) ... **Jessie Mann** recorded a career-high 10 saves against Oakland. She has 197 career saves which is 18 behind the all-time lead in Jaguars history. Mann is already the all-time leader in minutes, wins, starts, matches and shutouts.

OAKLAND: Oakland continued its recent strong play with two conference wins over Southern Utah (2-0) and IUPUI (3-0) ... Marianne Samdal tallied a team-leading four points over the two matches and now has 15 points which is second on the team ... The Golden Grizzlies recent surge will be tested this week with a home match against Oral Roberts and a road affair with conference-leading Valparaiso.

ORAL ROBERTS: Oral Roberts evened up its record in Mid-Con play with a 2-1 win over Western Illinois. **Erin Pemberton** provided the game-winner in the last regular-season home match for the Golden Eagles while **Shelbi Morrison** picked up her first career win in goal ... Oddly, the preseason favorite in the Mid-Con has yet to win a true road match (0-3-0) this season. They will look to break that streak as their final three matches are all road contests.

SOUTHERN UTAH: Southern Utah went 1-1-0 last week with a loss to conference foe Oakland (2-0) and a non-conference win over Cleveland State (2-0) ... **Holly Davis** has been the backbone of a defense that has allowed a league-low 13 goals (1.0 per game) ... **Tara Olson** picked up a goal and an assist last week to raise her season point total to 14, tops on the Thunderbirds and sixth in the Mid-Con.

VALPARAISO: Valparaiso won its fourth conference match with a 2-0 win over IUPUI and later in the week, topped Cleveland State on the road, 3-1 ... The Crusaders are a school record 6-0 at home ... Erin Murray and Emily King climbed up the school record books last week. Murray is the all-time leader in shutouts (10) while King is second all-time in points (40) ... Kendall Brown tallied her league-leading 10th goal against Youngstown State

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois split a pair of conference road matches against Centenary (5-1) and Oral Roberts (2-1). The win over Centenary gave the Westerwinds a school record sixth win this season ... WIU leads the Mid-Con in goals (29) and goals per game (2.23) but also leads conference play in goals allowed (9).
