AROUND THE MID-CON...

CONFERENCE PLAY WINDS DOWN: Valparaiso (4-1-0) suffered its first league loss with a 2-1 setback to Oakland but clinched at least a share of the regular season title and a berth in the Mid-Con Championship. Western Illinois checks in second with 10 points (3-2-1) and is the only team finished with league play. Oral Roberts and Oakland (3-2-0) are tied for third with nine points apiece. Southern Utah (2-1-2) is within striking distance with eight points with a key matchup against Valparaiso next week.

OF NOTE: Centenary's **Ali Hilsher** broke two school records in the 2-0 loss to Southern Utah. She set the single-match record with 19 saves, breaking the mark she set twice this season as well as the single-season saves record (137). Hilsher also ranks seventh in the NCAA in saves per game (9.08) as well as 14th in shots on goal save percentage (.874).

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary dropped its only league match of the week against Southern Utah (2-0) but snapped a three-match losing streak with a win over Nicholls State (3-1) ... **Ali Hilsher** had a record breaking week as she surpassed her own single-match saves record with 19. Her 137 saves are a Centenary single-season record and rank fourth on the Mid-Con single-season saves list. Hilsher is also seventh in the NCAA in saves per game (9.08) and 14th in shots on goal save percentage (.874).

IUPUI: IUPUI dropped a pair of matches to Butler (2-0) and Western Illinois (3-1) and had a match against Detroit cancelled due to inclement weather ... **Jessie Mann** was solid in goal against WIU with seven saves ... The goal against the Westerwinds snapped the Jaguars' five-match scoreless streak.

OAKLAND: Oakland handed Valparaiso its first league loss with a 2-1 win two days after falling to Oral Roberts by the same score. **Jessica Boyle** tallied the game-winner against the Crusaders ... **Kristi Swaving** tallied her 10th goal of the season against Valpo, tying her for the league lead ... The Golden Grizzlies win at Valpo improved them to 5-0 all-time at Eastgate Field.

ORAL ROBERTS: Oral Roberts moved to 3-2-0 in conference play with a 2-1 win over Oakland. The win over OU was the first true road win for the Golden Eagles this season, snapping an 0-4-1 stretch dating back to last season ... ORU will play its final non-conference and conference matches this week against Missouri State and IUPUI.

SOUTHERN UTAH: Southern Utah kept up the pace in the race for postseason competition with a 2-0 win over Centenary and added a thrilling 2-1 overtime non-conference win over LSU-Shreveport last week ... **Catherine Johnson** tallied both goals against the Ladies ... The Thunderbirds will wrap up their conference schedule against Valparaiso on Saturday in a match that looms large for SUU's postseason hopes.

VALPARAISO: Valparaiso dropped its first conference match of the season to Oakland, 2-1 but bounced back to top IPFW two days later, 2-1... Despite the loss the Crusaders clinched at least a share of the regular season title and a berth in the Mid-Con Championship...

Kendall Brown continued her outstanding freshman campaign with an assist on the eventual game-winner against IPFW. The assist gives her 24 points this season, tops in the Mid-Con and tying the Crusaders single-season record.

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois won a pair of matches over Indiana schools IPFW (2-0) and conference foe IUPUI (3-1) ... **Ashley Hoch** recorded a goal and a pair of assists to lead the Westerwinds over IUPUI ... The match against the Jaguars was the Westerwinds final Mid-Con match of the season.
