MID-CON OPENS CONFERENCE PLAY: Western Illinois and Valparaiso opened the Mid-Con conference schedule as the Crusaders topped the Westerwinds, 2-1. Elsewhere, the other Mid-Con teams continued their non-conference schedule in preparation for conference match-ups.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary concluded the week with a 1-1-0 record to even up their record to 4-4-1 ... Ali Hilsher picked up 14 saves over the two matches to lead the Ladies effort ... Centenary will open up its Mid-Con schedule on Friday as the Ladies travel to Tulsa, Okla., to play defending champion Oral Roberts.

IUPUI: The Jaguars went dropped their first game of the week to Ball State (3-1) but bounced back to tie Murray State (2-2) on Sunday ... **Angie Pilat** returned from an injury to tally a goal in both matches ... The Jaguars will travel to Utah and Idaho for their next two games as they faceoff against Southern Utah in their Mid-Con opener and Boise State in non-conference action.

OAKLAND: Oakland traveled to the West coast for their second tournament of 2005 at the Loyola Marymount Tournament in Los Angeles, Calif., but dropped both games to Loyola Marymount (2-0) and Southern California (3-0) ...
