MID-CON SCHEDULE GETS INTO SWING: Six of the seven Mid-Con women's soccer teams have now played a conference game as the calendar nears October. Oral Roberts notched a 1-0 win over Centenary to tie Valparaiso for the early lead while IUPUI and Southern Utah tied.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary dropped two matched against Oklahoma schools Tulsa (4-0) and Oral Roberts (1-0) ... Ali Hilsher notched seven saves in the Oral Roberts ... The Ladies lone match of the upcoming week is against Grambling, kick-off is scheduled for 5 p.m.

IUPUI: IUPUI began its conference schedule against Southern Utah and tied the Thunderbirds (0-0) ... Jessie Mann kept SUU at bay with five saves ... The Jaguars won't play again until October 5 when they host IPFW.

OAKLAND: The Golden Grizzlies dropped their only match last week, a tough fought 3-2 home loss to NR/#22 Michigan ... **Kristi Swaving** led the way for OU with a goal and an assist against the Wolverines ... After starting the season 3-1-1, Oakland has lost three straight to fall to 3-4-1.

ORAL ROBERTS: Oral Roberts had the best and busiest week in the Mid-Con with wins against John Brown (2-1), Centenary (1-0) and Northern Iowa (6-1) ... All-America candidate **Jessica Kellogg** had the best scoring output this season in the Mid-Con with an eight point effort (three goals, two assists) against Northern Iowa ... The Golden Eagles will play in-state rival Tulsa on Tuesday before hosting hosting Valparaiso on October 1.

SOUTHERN UTAH: The Thunderbirds only match last week ended up being a scoreless tie against IUPUI SUU outshot the Jaguars 16-5, including a 5-2 advantage on goal, but could not push across the equalizer ... Southern Utah will play in-state rival Boise State on Monday before taking a cross-country flight to Indiana State to take on the Sycamores.

VALPARAISO: After winning its conference opener two weeks ago, Valparaiso has struggled to a 0-2-1 mark against Northwestern (2-0), North Dakota State (2-0) and Creighton (0-0) ... After scoring 19 goals in their first seven games, the Crusaders offense has not recorded a goal in three consecutive games ... The scoreless tie against Creighton was just the fourth in school history ... Despite their recent offensive struggles, Kendall Brown has been a bright spot. She is currently ranked 17th in the nation in points per game (2.29) and 12th in goals per game (1.0)

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois dropped its only game of the week to Evansville, 6-4, but put up big offensive numbers. Both schools recorded 19 shots, with Evansville leading on shots on goal, 13-10 ... **Kim Schuneman** led the way with a goal and an assist .. After only allowing eight goals in their previous seven games, the six goals allowed by the Westerwinds set a season-high.
