MID-CON TEAMS CONTINUE STRONG NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: Another week of non-conference action saw Mid-Con teams continue to post impressive performances and wins. The Mid-Con is now 17-13-5 in non-conference action, an impressive .557 winning percentage.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: The Ladies had symmetry to their week as they finished a three-game homestand against Northwestern State (1-2), Texas State (2-1) and Southern Mississippi (0-0) with a 1-1-1 record... Centenar has been outshot by its opponents in every game this season ... Goalkeeper **Ali Hilsher** set a school record for single-game saves against Southern Mississippi with 17, breaking the old mark of 16.

IUPUI: The Jaguars dropped two road matches last week to Evansville (2-0) and Indiana State (3-1) ...
