
Saving thousands of dollars annually

In addition to accelerating review cycles, Adobe Acrobat and Adobe PDF allow staff and clients to zoom in on design elements to check the accuracy of small details, which is impossible to do with faxes or printed copies. As a result, every part of a design is accessible, making it easier to catch potential problems up front.

After reviewed files are returned to 1185, the firm's staff can combine comments from all reviewers into a single file to ensure that no one's feedback is overlooked. Says Chan, "Reviewing materials in Adobe PDF makes it easier for everyone. Clients know that the materials they are viewing onscreen are accurate, and we can more easily read and address their edits."

Integration with leading design tools

Integration among the Adobe Creative Suite 2 applications aids 1185 Design staff as they rush to meet client deadlines.
