Gabrielli helped Oakland to a Mid-Con sweep of Western Illinois on the road, which pushed the Golden Grizzlies' win streak to five games. After picking up two hits in a 10-8 win over Toledo early in the week, Gabrielli produced many runs in the series against Western Illinois. In the first game, a 7-1 win, he had two hits and drove in a run. He slugged a three-run homer to put Oakland up in the second win (6-4), and had a double and drove in three runs in the final game of the series, a 10-9 win. He batted .500 (7-14) with seven RBIs and scored five runs for the week.



**Troy Pickford, Oral Roberts

Pickford posted his best outing of the season in a 12-2 win over Valparaiso, one of four games the Golden Eagles took from the Crusaders over the weekend. Pickford went all seven innings in the win, allowing one earned on three hits (all singles) while striking out a career-high 14. He also earned a relief win earlier in the week with 3.1 scoreless innings against NW Oklahoma State. For the week, Pickford went 2-0 with a 0.87 ERA, allowed five hits and struck out 17 in 10.1 innings of work.

AROUND THE MID-CON...

Chicago State (3-22, 0-4 Mid-Con): Chicago State lost four games, including a pair of league games to Southern Utah... Jerrold Brock stole three bases at Notre Dame... Dan Newgent had two hits and homered at Northern Illinois... Nick Troy had two hits in an 8-2 loss to Southern Utah, and went the distance on the mound in a 3-1 loss, giving up four hits and two earned runs while striking out six.

Oakland (14-23, 5-2 Mid-Con): Oakland won four games, including three at Western Illinois in league play, to push its win streak to five games... the Golden Grizzlies scored 10 runs in the eighth inning to beat Toledo, 10-8... Spencer Hynes homered and drove in three runs off the bench... Jared Thomas struck out 10 and allowed two hits and no runs in a 7-1 win over Western Illinois in the first game of a league series... Mid-Con Player of the Week Matt Gabrielli belted a three-run homer in the first inning of a 6-4 win... Oakland rallied from a deficit in the final game of the series to win, 10-9... Gabrielli had two hits and drove in three runs in the finale, and batted .500 (7-14) with eight RBIs for the week... Peter Varon homered three times in four games as well.

Oral Roberts (29-14, 6-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts recovered from a losing streak to win six straight games, including four from Valparaiso in league play... Doug Bernier's two-run single in the seventh was the difference in a 5-4 win over NW Oklahoma State... Andrew Sanderson pitched five scoreless innings of relief, striking out five for the win... Eric Thornton belted a three-run homer to key an 11-0 win in the nightcap... Wilton Reynolds slugged a home run in a 7-3 win over Valparaiso to start the series... Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week Troy Pickford struck out 14 in seven innings to beat Valparaiso, 12-2... Thornton doubled twice and drove in five... Dennis Bigley allowed four hits and no runs in seven innings of work in another 12-2 win over Valpo, while Billy Joe Richardson homered from both sides of the plate... Bigley belted a three-run homer in a 5-0 win in the series finale... Pickford went 2-0 for the week with a 0.87 ERA, and struck out 17 in 10.1 innings... Reynolds belted three home runs, while Thornton batted .375 with 11 RBIs in six games... Oral Roberts is 56-2 in league play since the beginning of 2000.

Southern Utah (9-28, 4-2 Mid-Con): Southern Utah lost to UNLV, but beat Chicago State twice on the road (8-2, 3-1)... Aaron Lancaster homered and drove in two against UNLV... Shane Perkins allowed one earned run and struck out eight in seven innings to beat Chicago State in the first game... McKay Wilkerson had four hits off the bench... he is one of four Southern Utah players with a four-hit game this season... James Anderson became the school's all-time winningest pitcher with a win in the nightcap... he scattered seven hits and allowed one earned run... he needs three innings pitched and one start on the mound to become the school's career leader in those categories as well.

Valparaiso (8-24-1, 2-4 Mid-Con): Valparaiso won two non-conference games before dropping four in league play to Oral Roberts... Dan Schrum had four hits and homered twice against Northwestern... the Crusaders scored two runs in the fifth inning in a rain-shortened win over Bethel, while Tom Starck provided five innings of three-hit work on the mound... Valpo scored eight times in its last two at-bats to beat Horizon League leader Illinois-Chicago, 16-11... the Crusaders belted six homers, including two by Sean Peickert... Mark Pedersen became the school's career leader in doubles (54) with three in the series at Oral Roberts.

Western Illinois (5-32, 0-5 Mid-Con): Western Illinois lost five straight games, including three in league play to Oakland... Joe Rooney had three hits in a loss at Iowa... the Leathernecks dropped a pair of close games in a twinbill against Oakland, losing 6-4 and 10-9... Jeff Wellwood went 5-for-8 in the two games, and became the school's career leader in hits (190) and doubles (41) in the process... Wellwood homered three times in the two games.

ORAL ROBERTS RIGHTS SHIP WITH SIX STRAIGHT WINS

Oral Roberts had lost five straight games heading into last week, but the Golden Eagles reversed course by winning six straight games, including four in league play against Valparaiso. Oral Roberts swept a pair of games from NW Oklahoma State, winning 5-4 in the first game (on a two-run single by Doug Bernier in the seventh inning) and 11-0 in the nightcap. The Golden Eagles outscored Valparaiso, which was previously unbeaten in league play, by a 36-7 margin in four games. Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week Troy Pickford earned his second win of the week in dominating fashion, striking out a career-high 14 in seven innings in a 12-2 win in the second game of the series. Dennis Bigley was the story on the second day, as he tossed seven scoreless innings in a 12-2 win in the first game, and clubbed a three-run homer in a 5-0 win in the fourth and final game of the series.

THREE WEEKS, THREE OAKLAND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

For the third straight week, an Oakland player received Mid-Con Player of the Week honors. Matt Gabrielli joined Nick DiPonio and Peter Varon, who won in the two preceding weeks. Gabrielli keyed a three-game sweep on the road at Western Illinois by driving in seven of his eight runs for the week and batting .455. His three-run homer in the first inning of game two helped in a 6-4 win.

VALPO GETS HOMER HAPPY AGAINST THE FLAMES

Valparaiso got the best of Horizon League leader Illinois-Chicago, beating the Flames by a 16-11 score. The Crusaders belted six home runs and scored eight times in the seventh and eighth innings to pick up the win. Two of those homers came off the bat of Sean Peickert, while Marc Boggio, Mike Jaroscak, Dan Schrum and Caleb Kimmel also added dingers. Illinois-Chicago was 27-8 heading into the game, and its pitching staff was ranked among the nation's best. All 16 of the runs the Crusaders scored in the win were earned, and they racked up 17 hits as a team.

ORAL ROBERTS TABBED TO WIN MID-CON BASEBALL CROWN

Once again, Oral Roberts was chosen as the favorite to win the Mid-Continent Conference baseball crown in a preseason vote of league coaches. The Golden Eagles, who have won three regular-season and four tournament titles since joining the Mid-Con in the 1998 season, received five of six first-place votes in the preseason poll, easily outdistancing second-place Valparaiso, which received the other first-place tally. Southern Utah finished third in the poll, and was followed by Oakland, Western Illinois and Chicago State.

MID-CON TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD IN TULSA; WINNER RECEIVES NCAA BID

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Baseball Tournament will take place at J.L. Johnson Stadium in Tulsa, Okla., on the campus of Oral Roberts University, from May 23-25. The top four teams (according to conference standings) will take place in the double-elimination event, and the tourney winner will receive the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Baseball Tournament. Oral Roberts will host the Mid-Con Tournament for the fifth straight season, and will be looking for its fifth NCAA trip in as many years.

ORAL ROBERTS' GOLLOWAY NAMED TO USA BASEBALL COACHING STAFF

Oral Roberts head coach Sunny Golloway received some good news earlier this spring, when he was named as one of three assistant coaches for the 2002 USA Baseball National Team, a squad of collegiate all-stars that will be playing roughly 30 games this summer on the USA Baseball Red, White and Blue Tour. The team is scheduled to play against the Japanese Collegiate All-Stars in June and will then tour the United States on the Red, White and Blue Tour. After that, the team will compete in the Honkbal Baseball Classic in The Netherlands, as well as the FISU World Baseball Championships in Italy in August. This will be Golloway's first USA Baseball coaching experience.

ORAL ROBERTS SOLID AT JOHNNY QUIK CLASSIC

Oral Roberts posted a good showing in one of the premier annual college baseball tournaments, finishing third of eight teams at the Pepsi/Johnny Quik Classic, hosted by Fresno State. The Golden Eagles went 4-2 in the six-day affair, beating Fordham (7-1), Liberty (21-5), Illinois State (16-3) and Gonzaga (4-1). David Castillo was the offensive ringleader, as he posted four consecutive multi-hit games and batted .500 (12-24) with four doubles, four home runs and 12 RBIs. Michael Rogers continued his All-America effort with a pair of complete game wins, beating Fordham and Gonzaga. He struck out 10 and allowed only 10 hits and one earned run, good for a 0.50 ERA.

SOUTHERN UTAH'S ANDERSON METHODICAL IN SHUTOUT WIN

Southern Utah topped Air Force by a score of 9-0 on Mar. 27, thanks to a terrific effort from starter James Anderson. Anderson used only 97 pitches in the nine-inning, complete game effort, striking out three and scattering six hits. The whitewash was the third of his career, making him the school's all-time leader in that category.

ORAL ROBERTS' RECIO EARNS NATIONAL HONOR

Oral Roberts beat visiting Kansas by an 8-0 score on Apr. 2, thanks to a noteworthy performance by starter Rene Recio. He tossed a one-hit, complete game shutout at the Jayhawks, struck out 13 batters, and faced just one hitter over the minimum. He struck out more than one hitter in five of nine innings, and set down 15 in a row after allowing a single in the third. Recio was named the Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season, and was also honored as the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Pitcher of the Week.

ORAL ROBERTS EARNS RANKING FROM NCBWA

An 11-game win streak and an 8-3 win over nationally ranked Oklahoma State helped Mid-Con preseason favorite Oral Roberts earn its first ranking this season. The Golden Eagles were ranked No. 32 in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association poll for the week of April 10.
