Oral Roberts' Scott Campbell put together a hot week at the plate for the Golden Eagles, as they picked up wins over Oklahoma and Texas-Pan American. Campbell batted .583 (7-12), and hit safely in all four games. Campbell's week was highlighted a 3-for-5 effort in an 8-7,

11-inning loss to Texas-Pan American, in which he homered and drove in two. He also had two hits, including a double, drove in two and was hit by three pitches in a 14-5 win over Texas-Pan Am. For the week, he scored five times, drove in five, slugged 1.000 and posted a .737 on-base percentage, while going perfect in the field in nine chances.

Bigley allowed just one hit in seven shutout innings of work to earn his second straight win. He needed just 69 pitches to tame the Texas-Pan line-up, fanning two and walking none. In his last 16.0 innings of work, Bigley has allowed just four hits and one run and picked up two wins.

LEAGUE PLAY READY TO GO: The six Mid-Con teams will begin league play this weekend. Preseason favorite Oral Roberts, which will be trying for its fifth straight regular-season crown in 2003, opens with four games at Valparaiso. Chicago State will play a series at Southern Utah, while Oakland will host Western Illinois.

FINALLY! THE STREAK IS SNAPPED: Chicago State head coach Terrence Jackson had to be thrilled to get his first road win of the year, and that victory doubled in importance since it broke a long losing streak for his Cougars. Chicago State edged Cleveland State by a 6-5 score in the second game of a doubleheader on April 12, which stopped both a 15-game losing streak and a 21-game road losing skid that dated back to last season. Mike Slowik had two hits, drove in two and stole two bases to help offensively, while Danny Braswell did not give up an earned run in three innings of relief work to pick up the win.

BIGLEY MAKING PITCH FOR POSTSEASON HONORS: If the last two weeks are any indication, Oral Roberts' Dennis Bigley may end up earning Mid-Con Pitcher of the Year honors when the season winds up. Bigley, who was named the NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week last week after beating Miami (Fla.), was cited as the Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week for the second straight week. In beating Texas-Pan American by a 14-5 score, Bigley tossed seven shutout innings and allowed one hit while throwing just 69 pitches. In his last two starts, which span 16.0 innings, Bigley has allowed one run on four hits, fanned 11 and picked up two wins.

FROM ROLE PLAYER TO BIG HITTER: Oral Roberts' Scott Campbell served his time as a role player for the Golden Eagles the last three years, but Campbell stepped to the forefront and shined at the plate last week as Oral Roberts won two of four games. Campbell went 6-for-9 in Oral Roberts' series against Texas-Pan American, and his .583 average for the week helped to earn him Mid-Con Player of the Week accolades. Campbell had three hits, including a homer, in the first game of the series, and had two hits, drove in two and was hit by three pitches in a 14-5 win in game two.

HOW COULD THIS BE DISAPPOINTING?: Oral Roberts head coach Sunny Golloway recently bemoaned his young team's inconsistency this season, but the list of Golden Eagle victims this year includes some big-named programs. Not only has Oral Roberts beaten then-No. 9 Miami (Fla.) by a 10-1 score, but the Golden Eagles have also topped Wichita State and Kansas, and swept Kent State. Miami is currently ranked 11th in the ABCA poll, while the other three teams are receiving votes.

OF NOTE: Oral Roberts' David Castillo leads the Mid-Con with 10 home runs... Valpo's Adam Paetznick saved both ends of the Crusaders' sweep of IPFW, raising his league-leading saves total to four... Valpo is 5-0 at home this season, but has yet to win a road game... Oakland stopped an eight-game losing streak with an 8-1 win over Madonna, in which Gerry Dufour went 4-for-4 and scored three times... Western Illinois' six-game losing skid was stopped with a 13-1 win over Illinois College, as Clint Buchen had four hits, scored twice and stole two bases.
