David Castillo, Oral Roberts Jr., C, Corpus Christi, Texas

Oral Roberts' David Castillo shined in the Golden Eagles' four games against nationally ranked foes last week, batting a combined .412 (7-17) against No. 24 Arkansas and in a three-game series at No. 9 Miami (Fla.). He had two hits in each game of the series at Miami,

belting two home runs and driving in six runs. Castillo, who slugged .824 for the week, hit a two-run dinger in the third inning of the Golden Eagles' 10-1 win over Miami in the second game of the series.

PITCHER Dennis Bigley, Oral Roberts So., RHP, Lancaster, Texas

Oral Roberts' Dennis Bigley posted the best performance of his career over the weekend, firing a complete game three-hitter to beat No. 9 Miami (Fla.), 10-1, on the road. Bigley fanned seven in the win, which was the first nine-inning complete game of his career. At one

point, he set down ten straight batters; he also went 2-for-4 with two runs scored, an RBI and a stolen base. He lowered his ERA by more than a run (to 4.05) with his performance, which helped the Golden Eagles to the first win by a Mid-Con team over a top-ten ranked team since Valparaiso beat then No. 1 Notre Dame in 2001.



ONE WIN: Mid-Con teams combined to play 17 games last week, but only Oral Roberts was able to take away a win. Chicago State lost eight games (dropping two each to Illinois-Chicago and Eastern Illinois and four at IPFW), Oakland fell four times (at home against Eastern Michigan and Detroit and twice at Bowling Green), Southern Utah lost at home to UNLV, Valparaiso lost a trio of contests (one at Notre Dame and two at UW-Milwaukee), and Western Illinois lost twice at Nebraska. Only Oral Roberts was able to take away a win; after losing at Arkansas, the Golden Eagles took one of three games at Miami (Fla.)

STIFF COMPETITION: Mid-Con teams squared off against some of the nation's best last week. Oral Roberts lost at Arkansas, which was ranked No. 24 by the ABCA, then lost two of three games at Miami (Fla.), ranked ninth by both the ABCA and Baseball America. Southern Utah dropped a contest at home to No. 24 (BA) UNLV, Valparaiso lost at No. 19 (BA) Notre Dame, and Western Illinois fell short twice at No. 14/11 Nebraska.

BEST IN A LONG TIME: Oral Roberts' 10-1 win at Miami (Fla.) was the biggest for a league team in some time. The Golden Eagles' victory was the first by a Mid-Con team over a top ten squad since Valparaiso defeated then-No. 1 Notre Dame in 2001.

BIGLEY THE BEST AROUND LAST WEEK: Oral Roberts' Dennis Bigley picked a great time to have the best performance of his career, which translated into his selection both as the Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week and the NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week. Bigley tossed his first nine-inning complete game, allowing just three hits in a 10-1 win against No. 9/9 Miami (Fla.). He retired ten batters in a row at one point in the game, and lowered his ERA by more then a run (to 4.05). He also helped himself at the plate, going 2-for-4 with an RBI, scoring twice and stealing a base.

CASTILLO DOESN'T BACK DOWN FROM NATION'S BEST: Oral Roberts' David Castillo, who was named last year's Mid-Con Player of the Year, didn't shy away from facing some of the nation's best competition last week. In four games against ranked teams, Castillo batted .412 (7-17) with two home runs, seven RBIs and an .824 slugging percentage. After picking up a hit against Arkansas in a 9-3 loss, he collected multi-hit games in each contest at Miami (Fla.). He hit a pair of two-run homers against the Hurricanes, including one in a 10-1 win. He earned his third Mid-Con Player of the Week citation of the year.

OF NOTE: Valparaiso played its doubleheader against UW-Milwaukee at Miller Park, home of the Milwaukee Brewers... since winning four straight to start an 11-game homestand, Southern Utah has lost seven straight games in its home park... Chicago State has lost 13 straight games. The Cougars were shutout four times in as many games in a series at IPFW.
