Grant Plumley, Oral Roberts Sr., SS, Lake Forest, Calif.

Oral Roberts' Grant Plumley had a hand in each of the Golden Eagles' four wins last week, which pushed their win streak to 10 games. Plumley had at least two hits and two RBIs in each game as Oral Roberts beat SW Missouri State, No. 18/23 UC Irvine,

Washington State and Pepperdine. He doubled scored twice and drove in two against SW Missouri State, had three hits against UC Irvine, hit a game-winning two-run homer to beat Washington State, and had two doubles among his three hits against Pepperdine. He batted .714 (10-14) with five runs scored and nine RBIs for the week and slugged 1.143, thanks for four extra-base hits. (Also nominated - Tony Cardone, CC; B.J. Oral Roberts' Sean Sorrow helped the Golden Eagles extend their win streak to 10 games with a pair of wins last week. Sorrow tossed his first career complete game, striking out 11 while allowing no walks and six hits, in a 5-1 win over 2003 College

World Series participant SW Missouri State. He followed that up by tossing six innings, allowing three runs while fanning five, in a 13-3 win over Pepperdine, which locked up the Yellow Book Classic title.
