Josh Lex, Oral Roberts Sr., 1B/C, Elk Grove, Calif.

Oral Roberts' Josh Lex keyed his team's offense as it won three of four games - all on the road - against a pair of nationally ranked foes. In a 13-9 win at No. 10/10 Wichita State, Lex went 4-for-5 with a home run and four RBIs. He also went 3-for-5 with an RBI in a 9-7 win over No. 15/23 Arizona State in the series opener, and belted a two-run homer in the seventh inning of a 6-5 win at Arizona State that ended up being the difference in the series clincher. Lex, who has hit safely in 17 of his last 18 games (including all four last week), batted .474 (9-19) with two homers and seven RBIs in the four games. *(Also nominated - Derrick Bass, CSU; Amos Burgess, SUU; Keith Keslinke, VU; Aaron Milliken, WIU)*

Ryan Zimmerman, Southern Utah Fr., RHP, Hyrum, Utah

Southern Utah rookie Ryan Zimmerman won both of his starts last week, the second of which was the best of his young career. Zimmerman helped the Thunderbirds to a twinbill split at Utah by going all nine innings in the nightcap, tying his career high with seven strikeouts in a 7-6 win. He retired 11 of 12 batters in one stretch and limited the Utes to one run over the final five innings. Zimmerman then hurled Southern Utah to its only win in the series at Western Illinois, tossing six shutout innings and allowing only three hits while fanning seven more in a 10-1 win. Zimmerman went 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA, fanning 14 and walking only two in 15.0 innings of work. *(Also nominated - Paul Darby, CSU; Justin Ramsey, ORU; Adam Knobel, VU; Nathan Miller, WIU)*

THREE TOP 25 WINS MOVE GOLDEN EAGLES INTO BASEBALL AMERICA POLL: Oral Roberts is slowly making believers out of the national pollsters. The 26-7 Golden Eagles, who won at No. 10/10 Wichita State and took two of three at No. 15/23 Arizona State last week, are ranked No. 24 this week in Baseball America's Top 25. They also have moved up to Nos. 21 and 22, respectively, in the Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA polls. Oral Roberts is just outside of the ESPN Coaches Poll as well.

BIGLEY ON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST: Oral Roberts two-way standout Dennis Bigley was one of 30 players listed on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award watch list last week. Bigley, who is 6-1 with a 2.53 ERA on the mound and hitting .383 with seven home runs and 26 RBIs, was one of four 'utility' players listed among the nation's top players. Bigley was also tabbed as a National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and as the NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week last week.

OF NOTE: Valparaiso took three of four games at Centenary to start league play, and overcame last-inning deficits with two-out rallies in both games three and four... Chicago State stopped a 23-game road losing streak that had dated back to last season when it beat IPFW (7-4) in the first game of a doubleheader... Oakland belted six home runs in a 9-8 loss to Eastern Michigan... Western Illinois also won three of four games to begin conference play, winning in their final at-bat in games two and three.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary dropped four of five games last week, including three of four contests to Valparaiso in its first-ever Mid-Con series. After splitting the first two games of the set against Valpo, the Gents led final-inning leads slip away in both games three and four. A.J. Howes was an offensive standout in the conference set, batting .545 (6-11) with six RBIs in the four games, which included a pair of multi-hit games. Bobby Gilliam stole two bases last week to lift his season total to 16; he's three short of breaking the school's career record in the category.

CHICAGO STATE: Chicago State started last week by losing at No. 9/9 Notre Dame, but the Cougars then stopped a 14-game slide (and a 23-game road losing streak) by splitting a twinbill at IPFW. The Cougars led 3-0 in the fifth at Notre Dame before surrendering the lead. In the 7-4 game one win at IPFW, Paul Darby went the distance on the mound, fanning six in the win; Chicago State rallied with four runs in the last inning, including a two-run single from Derrick Bass that snapped a 5-5 tie.

OAKLAND: Oakland lost three of four games last week, but its only win was a 4-3 triumph over Madonna that snapped a 10-game losing streak. John Sullivan and Ty Herriott had two of the Golden Grizzlies' six home runs in a 9-8 loss to Eastern Michigan. Kyle Boehm fanned six in six innings of work to beat Madonna. Herriott added two more home runs against Rochester (Mich.); he and Sullivan are tied for the league lead with eight homers.

ORAL ROBERTS: Oral Roberts enjoyed one of its most important four-game stretches ever last week, picking up three wins in four contests against ranked teams on the road. The Golden Eagles jumped out to a 9-1 lead at No. 10/10 Wichita State only to see the hosts tie it up. However, Ricky Rivera drove in the game-winning run with a sac fly and added a two-run homer in 13-9 win. Mid-Con Player of the Week Josh Lex (.474-2-7 for the week) went 4-for-5 with a homer and four RBIs in the win. The Golden Eagles rallied from a 7-2 deficit to win at No. 15/23 Arizona State (9-7) in the first of a three-game set. Dennis Bigley tossed eight innings to win and move to 6-1, adding an RBI single in a four-run ninth-inning rally. Bigley hit a solo homer in the finale of the three-game set, but it was Lex's two-run homer in the seventh that was the difference in a 6-5 win that gave Oral Roberts the series win. Justin Ramsey had a hand in each win, picking up the relief win against Wichita State and earning saves in both wins at Arizona State. Oral Roberts is 24-0 when scoring at least five runs this season. Shortstop Grant Plumley has made just one error in 190 chances this season, good for a .995 fielding percentage.

SOUTHERN UTAH: Southern Utah split a pair of games at Utah then dropped three of four at Western Illinois in its first Mid-Con series of the season. Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week Ryan Zimmerman helped the Thunderbirds to the split against Utah by tossing his first complete game, tying a career high with seven strikeouts; Kurt Elliott had a double, triple and homer in the two games and drove in five runs. Zimmerman tossed six shutout innings, fanning seven more, in a 10-1 win in the finale at Western Illinois. He went 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA, fanned 14 and walked two in 15.0 innings of work. The Thunderbirds swiped 15 bases last week in six games. Amos Burgess batted .333 (8-24) in six games last week with four extra-base hits and six RBIs.

VALPARAISO: After dropping games at No. 9/9 Notre Dame and Northwestern, Valparaiso took three of four at Centenary in its first conference series. Mike Arensdorff homered and drove in two in the series-opening win at Centenary, while Tom Starck fanned seven in 6.1 innings to pick up the win. The Crusaders picked up wins in their final at-bat in games three and four, with both rallies coming with two outs. Valpo scored 12 times in the last three innings in game three - including six in the ninth - with Eddie Hannan giving them the win with a two-run single. In the nightcap, Keith Keslinke's two-run single in seventh capped a four-run rally. Adam Knobel earned saves in both ends of the doubleheader with a pair of scoreless innings.

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois started the week by coming up short on the road at Eastern Illinois, but the Leathernecks recovered by winning three of four games at home over Southern Utah to start league play. Ryan Malan homered as Western Illinois won 8-2 in the opener against Southern Utah; Pat Kohorst tossed 7.2 innings for the win, which was head coach Stan Hyman's 50th at the school. Aaron Milliken had two hits and drove in three in a 7-6, 10-inning win in game two, but the winning run scoring on a bases-loaded wild pitch; Jon Adams tossed 5.1 scoreless innings of relief for the victory, fanning five. Nathan Miller pitched seven innings and struck out eight in a no decision in game three, but Dan Davy's two-out, pinch-hit single in the ninth won it. Milliken batted .529 (9-17) for the week with four RBIs.

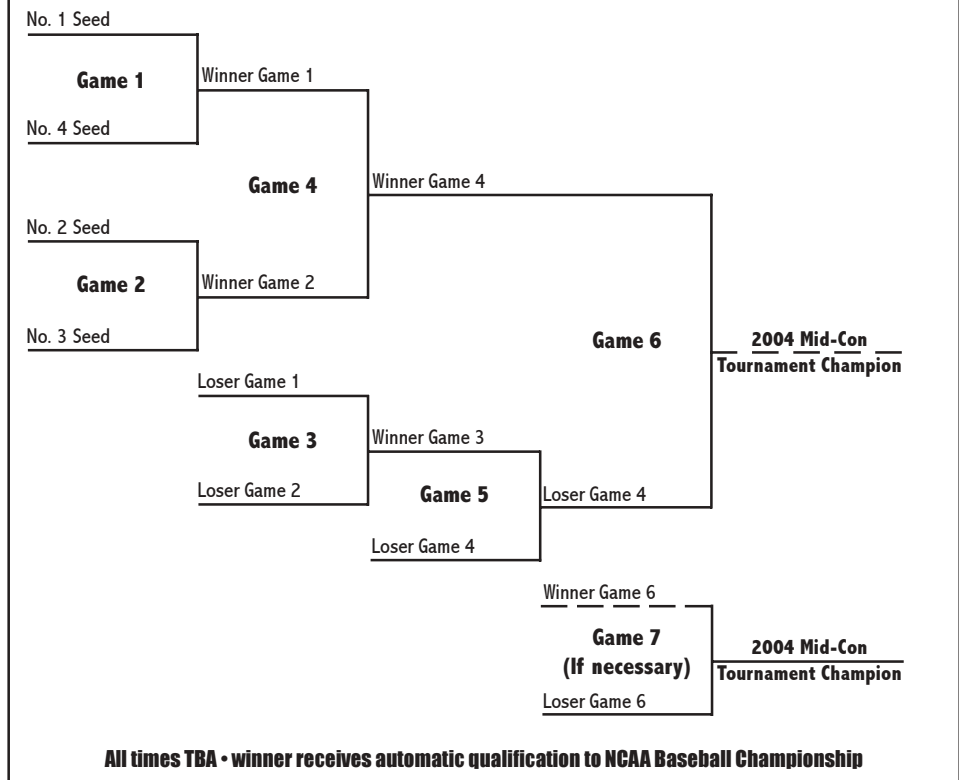
