Oral Roberts' Matt VanDerBosch had a monster weekend in leading the Golden Eagles to a four-game conference sweep of Chicago State. VanDerBosch went 11-for-17 (.647) in the series with two doubles, two triples and two home runs (good for a 1.353 slugging percentage), scored 12 times and drove in 11 runs. Including a two-hit performance against Oklahoma earlier in the week, VanDerBosch had four multi-hit games in five contests and hit .591 (13-22) for the week, lifting his batting average 47 points to .380, which ranks third in the Mid-Con. The home runs were his first of the 2004 campaign. (Also nominated - Bobby Gilliam, CC; Jonathan Sakurai, CSU; Dan Davy, WIU)

Oral Roberts' Dennis Bigley won his fifth Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week honor in eight weeks with his most convincing performance to date. In an 8-0 win in game two of the Golden Eagles' series against Chicago State, Bigley tossed the first Oral Roberts no-hitter since the 1986 season. He set down the first 16 batters of the game before hitting a man with one out in the sixth (he was erased on a double play). Bigley struck out a season-high 12 batters in the victory, which improved his record this year to 5-1, and lowered his ERA to a league-best 1.96. He has allowed only 50 baserunners in 59.2 innings this season. (Also nominated - David Ruffing, CC; Eric Brauer, VU; James Kalinowski, WIU)

BIGLEY NAMED NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK AFTER NO-HITTER: Oral Roberts' Dennis Bigley was tabbed as the Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week for the fifth time in eight weeks after tossing the school's first no-hitter since 1986 in an 8-0, seven-inning win over Chicago State. He retired the first 16 batters of the game and fanned a season-high 12 in the victory, which improved his record to 5-1 and dropped his ERA to 1.96. Bigley was also tabbed as one of Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week for his effort, making him the first Mid-Con player this season to earn such recognition.

VANDERBOSCH SIZZLES IN CONFERENCE SET VS. CHICAGO STATE: Oral Roberts' Matt VanDerBosch showed off his hitting stroke last week, going 11-for-17 against Chicago State, with two doubles, two triples and his first two home runs of the season. He also scored 12 runs, drove in 11 and stole two bases. His performance lifted his average 47 points to .380, which ranks second in the league behind teammates Ryan Welborn (.387) and Dennis Bigley (.381).

OF NOTE: Western Illinois' Nathan Miller picked up his third save of the season (his fifth career) in an 8-7 win over Illinois-Chicago. He's tied for school season and career records in the category... Oral Roberts continues to rank among the nation's elite. The Golden Eagles are 27th in Collegiate Baseball's poll and 24th according to the NCBWA poll... Centenary's David Ruffing allowed only four hits in a 2-0 shutout of Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on the road. He has not allowed a run in his last 18.0 innings.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: After falling short at Texas-Arlington, Centenary split a four-game series at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, winning two on the first day and losing twice on day two. David Ruffing tossed Centenary's first complete game shutout of the season in a 2-0 win in the first game against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, allowing just four hits in seven innings and retiring 15 straight batters in one stretch. Alex Valdivia and Jesse Newell each hit solo homers in that win, and Bobby Gilliam hit the first of his two home runs in the series in a 4-2 extra-inning win in the nightcap. Gilliam batted .467 (7-15) in the four-game weekend set to lift his batting average 27 points to .292. Ruffing has not allowed a run in his last 18.0 innings of work.

CHICAGO STATE: Chicago State's losing streak reached 13 games last week as it lost at Eastern Illinois in the middle of the week and four times at Oral Roberts in a conference-opening four-game series over the weekend. Brandon Candiano homered at Eastern Illinois, and John Torres hit a two-run homer in game one at Oral Roberts that helped the Cougars go up 4-0 in the first inning. Jonathan Sakurai had a pair of two-hit games at Oral Roberts and batted .500 (5-10) for the week.

OAKLAND: Oakland had a rough week on the road, losing once at Toledo and four times at Eastern Michigan to run its losing streak to eight games. The Golden Grizzlies put up plenty of offense in the five setbacks, scoring 37 runs (an average of 7.4 per game). John Sullivan had a great week at the plate, batting a team-high .625 (10-16) with three multi-hit games, including a pair of four-hit contests, and three doubles and a triple. Ty Herriott scored nine times in five games while batting .350 (7-20).

ORAL ROBERTS: After dropping a narrow 5-4 decision at state-rival Oklahoma, Oral Roberts opened conference play in style sweeping a four-game series from visiting Chicago State and outscoring the Cougars by a 56-8 margin. Mid-Con Player of the Week Matt VanDerBosch sizzled at the plate in five games, batting .591 (13-22) for the week. He was spectacular against Chicago State, going 11-for-17 (.647) in four games with two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 12 runs scored and 11 RBIs. As impressive as he was, no Golden Eagle performance was better than that of Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week Dennis Bigley, who no-hit Chicago State in an 8-0 win game two of the series, the first no-hitter by an Oral Roberts hurler since 1986. Bigley retired the first 16 batters of the game and struck out a season-high 12 in the win. Bigley also homered twice in the series-opening 21-6 win, and earned National Player of the Week honors from Collegiate Baseball. Oral Roberts is 18-1 at home this season.

SOUTHERN UTAH: Southern Utah was idle last week. It comes off of a two-week break by starting a 10-game road trip.

VALPARAISO: Valparaiso rallied from a 4-1 deficit at Indiana only to lose by a 6-4 count, then lost the first three games in a home-and-home series with IPFW before salvaging the finale, 4-0. Mike Arensdorff had a pair of three-hit games against IPFW and batted .438 (7-16) for the week to pace Valpo's offense; he had two doubles, scored twice and drove in two runs combined in games two and three. Eric Brauer allowed just one hit in five innings of work in the finale against IPFW, while Patrick Paulus pitched two innings of one-hit ball to wrap up the shutout. Kevin Perri had three hits and drove in two in the win.

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois opened a four-game series at Illinois-Chicago with an 8-7 win, but dropped the remaining three games of the set. James Kalinowski allowed one earned run in six innings to pick up the win, and Nathan Miller earned his third save of the season with a scoreless ninth. His three saves this season and five career saves tie for Western Illinois records. Dan Davy moved to the leadoff slot and batted .400 (6-15) in the four-game set, including a three-hit effort in game one in which he drove in two. Head coach Stan Hyman is one win away from reaching the 50-win plateau at Western Illinois.
