Blake Schultz, Western Illinois Sr., OF, Urbandale, Iowa

Western Illinois' Blake Schultz had a terrific series in a four-game split at Centenary, batting .471 (8-17) while hitting safely in each game of the series (pushing his hit streak to six games) and collecting two multi-hit contests. Much of Schultz's production in a single game of the set, as he went 4-for-4 with two doubles, a home run and a career-high nine RBIs in a 14-9 win; Schultz accounted for 10 of the Leathernecks' 14 runs in the victory. For the weekend, Schultz scored three runs, drove in 10, slugged .765 and added a stolen base. He also recorded a pair of assists from right field, throwing out a runner at third base and at home. Ryan Zimmerman, Southern Utah Fr., RHP, Hyrum, Utah

Southern Utah's Ryan Zimmerman helped the Thunderbirds to a series win against Valparaiso - and back into the race for a Mid-Con Tourney berth - by tossing a complete game in an 8-1 win over the Crusaders in the series finale. Zimmerman fanned a career-high eight batters in the win, including four of the last eight hitters he faced, while scattering seven hits and allowing just one walk. He retired the first six batters he faced, then did not allow a hit after the seventh inning. Zimmerman improved his record as a rookie to 5-4 while completing his second start of the season. OAKLAND MAKES MOVE INTO SECOND PLACE IN MID-CON STANDINGS: Oakland took three of four games from visiting Chicago State to move into sole possession of second place in the Mid-Con standings. Highlighting the Golden Grizzlies' series victory was a 22-1 win triumph in game three of the set, in which they record season highs in runs and hits (23). Ty Herriott did much of the damage, homering twice among his four hits and driving in seven. Oakland has won six of its last nine Mid-Con league games.

A CAREER IN A DAY: Western Illinois' Blake Schultz, last season's Mid-Con Newcomer of the Year, has missed 15 games because of injuries this season, but he spent one game trying to make up for all of his lost time over the weekend in a 14-9 triumph over Centenary. Schultz went 4-for-4 with two doubles, a home run and a career-high nine RBIs in the win. Schultz hit a two-run double as part of a six-run first inning, belted a three-run homer in the second inning, singled to lead off the fourth frame, hit a sacrifice fly to drive in a run in the sixth, knocked in three with another double in the seventh inning, and walked with a pair of runners on in the ninth. Schultz, who was named the Mid-Con Player of the Week, went 8-for-17 in the series and lifted his average to .314.

OF NOTE: Southern Utah's Ryan Zimmerman was named the Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season... after 696 career at-bats without a homer, Centenary's Tony Cardone finally went deep for the first time in a game three loss to Western Illinois... nationally ranked Oral Roberts is now ranked in the top 20 in all four college baseball national polls.

TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOKS:

CENTENARY: Centenary split a four-game set with visiting Western Illinois in league play, winning the nightcap in each of two doubleheaders. Tony Cardone batted .467 (7-15) in the series with multi-hit efforts in each of the first three games. Cardone lifted his team-best average to .383 (third in the Mid-Con) with his effort, and belted his first career home run in game three. Kevin Cassidy tossed five scoreless innings of relief in an 11-inning, 6-5 win in game two of the series; the Gents scored the winning run on a balk. With Centenary's pitching staff depleted, Will Kaage tossed his first career complete game in a 5-3 win in the series finale, scattering six hits and fanning two.

CHICAGO STATE: Chicago State both ends of a twinbill to visiting UW-Milwaukee, then lost three of four games at Oakland in league play. John Torres hit safely in five of six games during the week, including a pair of multi-hit games against UW-Milwaukee. The Cougars let a 6-2 lead slip away in game one at Oakland, as the hosts rallied for five runs in the last three innings to post a 7-6 win. However, Chicago State used a five-run inning of its own in the nightcap of that twinbill to win by a 6-4 count. Paul Darby went the distance, allowing only three hits while fanning five, to earn his third win of the season. Derrick Bass hit his first home run of the season in game three of the series and batted .444 (4-9) for the week.

OAKLAND: Oakland won three of four games from visiting Chicago State in league play to move into second place in the Mid-Con standings. Two of the Golden Grizzlies' wins in the series were by narrow margins - they rallied for five runs in the last three innings to post a 7-6 win in the opener (capped by Ryan Freibuenger's two-out single in the ninth), and won by a 4-2 count in the finale. Oakland collected season highs in runs (22) and hits (23) and belted five home runs while posting a 22-1 win in game three. Ty Herriott went 4-for-5 with a pair of homers and seven RBIs, Freibuenger had five hits and Ryan Heath homered and scored five times in the win. Dominic Carmosino fanned seven and carried a shutout into the ninth in the complete game win.

ORAL ROBERTS: Oral Roberts was idle last week, and will come off of a nine-day break with a non-league game this week. The Golden Eagles are still ranked in all four of college baseball's national polls - ABCA/ESPN Coaches (20), Baseball America (16), Collegiate Baseball (14) and NCBWA (16). Oral Roberts is three wins short of reaching the 40-win plateau for the seventh straight season.

SOUTHERN UTAH: Southern Utah got back in the race for a Mid-Con Tournament berth by taking three of four games from visiting Valparaiso. Amos Burgess went 4-for-4 and drove in the eventual game-winning run as part of a four-run rally to win game one, 8-5. Justin Abbott allowed two earned runs and fanned a career-high nine in his second straight complete game win. Jason Ruiz extended his hit streak to 15 games by hitting safely in each contest. Kurt Elliott homered among his three hits and scored the game-winning run in the 11th inning in a 9-8 triumph in game two. Mid-Con Pitcher of the Week Ryan Zimmerman fanned eight, including four of the last eight batters of the game, in an 8-1 win in the series finale. Josh Bolingbroke had two hits, including a homer, in that win, and has now homered in three straight Mid-Con series. Burgess batted .563 (9-16) with three multi-hit games and three stolen bases against Valpo.

VALPARAISO: Valparaiso opened last week by winning its second straight non-conference game on the road - an 11-6 win at Western Michigan - but then lost three of four contests in league play at Southern Utah, which dropped the Crusaders into a tie for fifth place in the conference standings. Valpo used a nine-run sixth inning to overcome a 6-1 deficit at Western Michigan; Matt Augustine homered among his two hits off the bench. Mike Arensdorff went 8-for-16 in the set at Southern Utah, and had four multi-hit games in five contests last week, lifting his average to a team-best .340.

WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois stayed even in Mid-Con play by splitting a four-game set at Centenary. The Leathernecks won the first game of both twinbills. Ryan Schmidgall and Jim Sane each had three hits in a 6-1 win the opener, while Pat Kohorst tossed a three-hitter and fanned four to pick up the complete game win. The Leathernecks scored four times in the fifth and sixth innings to force extra innings in game two, but lost in the 11th when the winning run was balked home. Mid-Con Player of the Week Blake Schultz, who batted .471 (8-17) in the series, had a career game in a 14-9 win in game three. Schultz went 4-for-4 with two doubles, a homer and a career-high nine RBIs. Kyle Malan added a grand slam in the first inning of that win and also homered in the night cap, and has hit a team-high 10 homers this season. Western is a victory away from matching last season's total of 25 wins.

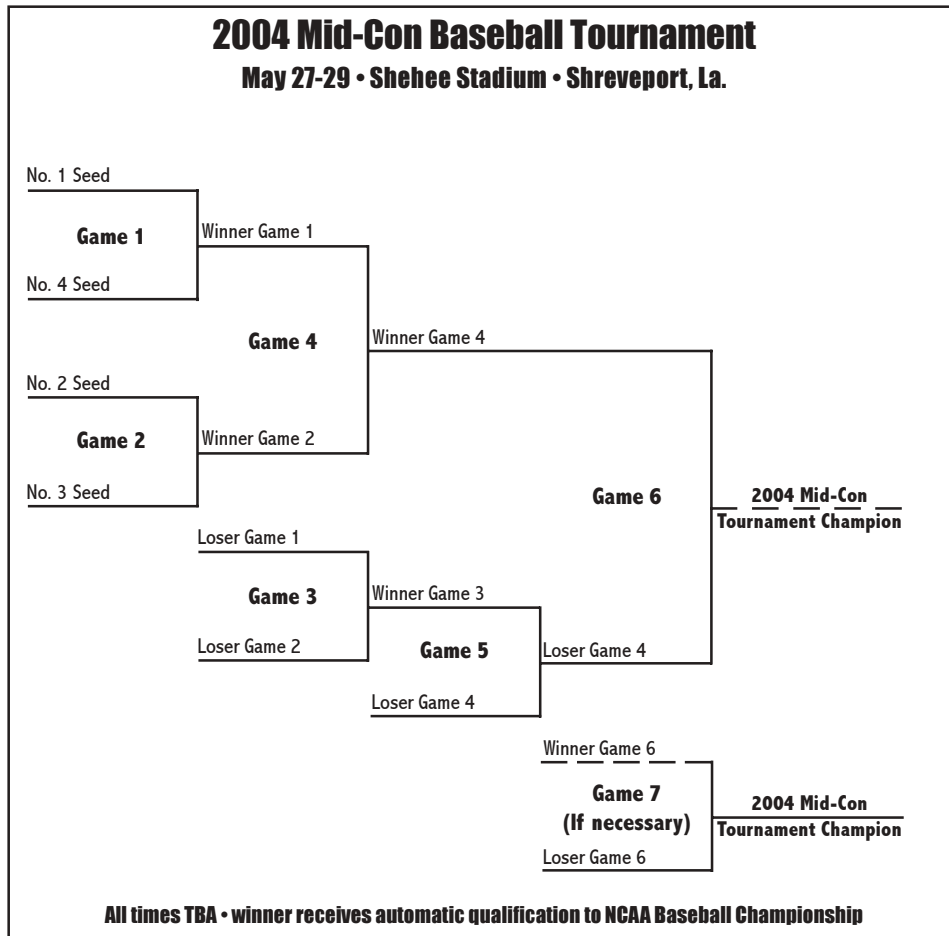
