



**VIMEO ANNOUNCES FINALISTS IN 2010 VIMEO AWARDS FOR THE BEST IN CREATIVE
ONLINE VIDEO**

*45 Videos Representing 9 Categories and 12 Countries Vie for the Honor of Best-in-Category and One \$25,000
Grant for Best Overall Video*

NEW YORK, Sept. 21, 2010 – Online video sharing site Vimeo®, an operating business of IAC [NASDAQ: IACI], today announced the top five [finalists](#) in each of nine categories in its first Vimeo Awards competition.

The finalists, representing 12 countries from around the world, were selected from more than 6,500 entries by an international panel of distinguished [judges](#) including M.I.A., David Lynch, Roman Coppola, Ted Hope, Lucy Walker, and Morgan Spurlock, to name a few. Screenings of the finalist videos will take place at the Vimeo Festival in New York on October 8-9.
