Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KCCM-FM, Moorhead, MN, hereby informs the Commission that KCCM went off the air on April 24' 2008 and is expected to either be off the air or operating at a very reduced power for at least a few weeks. The station suffered a lightening strike that caused severe damage to the transmission line and possibly to the antenna.

MPR intends to install a temporary antenna as soon as possible, but anticipates the station to be operating at less than 20% of its authorized power once the temporary antenna is installed. All reasonable efforts will be made to replace the damaged equipment and get the station back up to its authorized power as soon as possible once the full extent of the damage is determined and new equipment can be ordered and placed on the tower.
