Table notes The line breaks denote the pattern of clustering among the schools. Some 275 points separate HEC Paris at the top, from the school ranked number 75. The top 9 business schools from HEC to lese, form the top group. The second group is headed by EM Lyon, which would need to increase its score by 30 points in order to enter the top group. The third group is headed by the University of Cambridge: Judge. \square
