## The University Library (UB)

The UB is a lending library; 95% of its holdings can be borrowed. The UB has items from all academic disciplines with a special emphasis on the humanities, social sciences, interdisciplinary works, and electronic resources.

### The Library System

The library system of the Freie Universität Berlin has holdings of around 8.5 million items, which are held in the University Library (UB: 2.5 million) and 40 Departmental Libraries.

### Undergraduate Collection

The collection contains a large number of multiple copies of course textbooks which can be borrowed by FU students only.

### Dissertations Department

Here the dissertations and theses submitted at the FU are archived as well as a selection of theses and dissertations from other academic institutions.

### Documentation Center UN–EU

The UB is an official deposit library for publications of the United Nations and the European Union.



## Accessing Resources at the FU

### Library Portal & Primo

<http://primo.fu-berlin.de>

The FU Library Portal uses the discovery and delivery tool Primo, which provides an easy to use, single point of access to the entire spectrum of the university's collections and library resources.

The user account (borrowing, requesting, etc.) is integrated.

Through the Library Portal users also can search for resources held by the Charité and the Museum für Naturkunde (Berlin Natural History Museum).

They have access to licensed or free e-resources (for example, over 1,400 databases, 400,000 e-books, 40,000 e-journals, and millions of journal articles).

### Database searches

The Library Portal allows users to search sets of databases simultaneously. It also provides an overview of the free and licensed e-resources available at the FU.

### Off-campus access to e-resources

Members of the FU can access licensed e-resources from home via VPN and FU account. This service is not available to guests, who need to use a computer connected to the FU campus network.
