Subj: Painting and Identification of COMCBPAC Equipment; instructions concerning

Encl: (1) Directions for Application of Seabee Stencils to CBPAC Equipment

1. Purpose. To establish standards for painting and identifying Commander Naval Construction Battalions, Pacific equipment assigned to CBPACDET RVN.

2. Cancellation. CBPAC DET RVN/THAI 11200.1A.

3. Action. The painting and identification of the equipment to conform to the colors specified by this Instruction will be accomplished when the equipment is due for complete refinishing or when otherwise directed by the Officer in Charge, CBPACDET RVN. Vehicles requiring "touch up" will be painted the same color that is currently on the equipment.

a. Color. Seabee Team equipment will be painted as follows:

(1) The paint used will be green color No. 14064. Local mixing of paint is not authorized.

b. Identification.

(1) The location and markings will be in accordance with NAVDOCKS P-300 except USN numbers for administrative vehicles, which will be three inches in height. NAVDOCKS P-300 is available at CBPAC DET RVN Headquarters.

(2) Lettering and numbers will be applied with black paint. Stencils will be painted with glossy yellow paint.

(3) To readily identify all CBPAC automotive, construction, and materials handling equipment, a Seabee insignia, having a diameter of 8 inches or 12 inches will be painted on equipment as indicated in enclosure (1). Seabee insignia stencils will be provided by the Detachment Headquarters.

(4) To readily identify Seabee Team Allowance equipment, a red rectangle, having a vertical measurement of four inches and a horizontal measurement of six inches will be painted on the front and rear of all self-propelled automo-

tive Seabee Team allowance equipment and on both sides of all other Seabee Team Allowance equipment.

(5) To readily identify Seabee Team Augment equipment, a red triangle having a vertical measurement and a horizontal base measurement of four inches, will be painted on the front and rear of all self-propelled automotive Seabee Team Augment equipment and on both sides of all other Seabee Team Augment equipment.

c. Additional Markings.

(1) Value of Equipment. The words "This Equipment cost \$ _____" (the acquisition cost to nearest \$100) will be stenciled in black paint on all equipment except sedans. The letters will be one inch in height and the wording will be placed where it will be conspicuous to the operator either when entering or operating the equipment.

(2) Lifting Devices. Equipment which has a lifting device will have the following letters stenciled above the lifting device: "Lift Here". The letters will be one inch in height and in black paint.

(3) Tire Pressure. Tire pressure will be stenciled on all vehicles with pneumatic rubber tires i.e., "TP35". The letters will be one inch in height and in black paint. The location will be above the tire on the lower portion of the fender or other appropriate location on the body.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION OF SEABEE STENCILS TO SEABEE TEAM EQUIPMENT

1. Listed below are recommended locations for stenciling of equipment. These recommendations will be adhered to as closely as possible. In certain instances it is recommended that an eight inch stencil be painted on areas having less than eight inch dimensions. In such instances the stencil will be centered such that the Seabee itself is shown, without concern for the trim of the stencil.

In addition the Seabee insignia, 8 or 12 inch as appropriate shall be placed on miscellaneous non-USN equipment such as the acetylene generator and water treatment generator.
